PROM GUIDELINES.2017

Guidelines for Attending Prom:

- Students who have had a LTISS or DAEP placement this year are not eligible to attend the Prom.
- Freshmen or sophomores may attend the junior-senior prom only as a guest of a current Belton High School junior or senior.
- Students that have been determined to have an unacceptable attendance history are not eligible to attend the Prom. Exceptions must be approved by the principal.
- Students must be clear of fines in order to purchase prom tickets.
- Students must present valid current ID on entry. All guest must be under 21 and be pre-approved by APs. Guests must have photo ID – either a valid current school ID or valid state photo ID. All state photo IDs will be subject to Raptor checks on site.

Non-Entry into Prom:

- Administration has the right to refuse entrance to any student who is behaving in a manner that violates the Student Code of Conduct and may face additional consequences.
- Entrance will be denied to any student who is under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol and the student may face additional consequences.

Dress Guidelines:

- Young Men: dress shirts, ties, dress pants, dress shoes (jackets, suits, and tuxedos are optional)
- Young Ladies: semi-formal dresses or dress pants
- Modesty Guidelines: Please consider modesty when choosing a dress. Students who wear dresses considered to be too revealing may be required to wear a cover-up.
- Questionable attire will be left to the discretion of the Administrators on duty.

Dancing Guidelines:

- Dancing that is sexually suggestive or has sexual connotation will not be allowed. You will be given one warning. If you continue dancing in an inappropriate manner you will be escorted out and not allowed re-entry.
