

Arrival options (doors open at 7:15, bell rings at 7:45):

Car Rider: You may use either loop. As you enter the loop please be aware of other traffic and yield when necessary. Pull up to the first open spot against the curb. Each car spot will be marked by a numbered cone. Student exits from the right side of the car. Adults and safety patrol will be on duty to help your child. Do not park here and do not exit your car. **Attention CAR LOOP TWO:** When using Loop Two do not block the entrance of the bus loop leading to the back of the school. As you leave Loop Two, **ALWAYS** yield to buses.

Parent Walk Up: You may park in either parking lot (One or Loop Two). **Use the cross walk** and walk up to the front door.

Walkers: There will be a crossing guard at the entrance on Starlight Drive. This person will help your child cross the street. Your child will walk up the sidewalk and enter the school through the front doors. We will have an adult on duty at the curve to make sure your student is on the sidewalk at a safe distance from moving cars. Students will enter the building through the front door. You are welcome to walk with them to the front door.

Bus: Students will be dropped off in the back. Adults will be there to help them off the bus and in to the building.

*As your children enter the building on day one, we will mark your student's hand with a letter that designates how they will get home that day. This way any adult in the building can safely help with dismissal. Make sure you talk with your child about dismissal. Each homeroom teacher will coordinate dismissal with you but it is always good for your child to know exactly how they will get home.

*You may walk to your child's classroom on the first day. During the rest of that first week, you may walk your student in to the building and say goodbye in the foyer area. After the first week, we ask that you establish a goodbye routine in the car or at the front door of the school. We do not allow parents down the hallway as it has the potential to disrupt morning supervision of children. Safety is our number one priority. If you need to get a message or deliver something to a teacher, we will happily help you with that in the office. We will work with you in the case of an extenuating circumstance. After the first week of school, parents who walk their child to the school building should remain in the foyer. The foyer is between the double doors. This allows your child to gain confidence and independence. It also allows for better supervision of students and a timely start to instruction. There will be adults on duty to help your child get to his/her classroom.

Dismissal options (2:45pm):

Car Rider: You must commit to Loop One or Loop Two. We will seat your student outside accordingly. As you enter the loop please be aware of other traffic and yield when necessary. Pull up to the first open spot against the curb. Each car spot will be marked by a cone during the first week. Student enters on the right side of the car. Adults and safety patrol will be on duty to help your child. Do not park here and do not exit your car.

Attention CAR LOOP TWO: When using Loop Two do not block the entrance of the bus loop leading to the back of the school. As you leave Loop Two, **ALWAYS** yield to buses.

Parent Walk Up: You may park in either parking lot (Loop One or Two). Use the cross walk and walk up to the library door.

Walkers: Students will be escorted out of the first grade hallway and down the sidewalk. The crossing guard will help them cross and enter in to the neighborhood. Please review walking safety with your children if they are walking alone.

Bus/Day Care: Students will exit on the back side of the building and escorted to the appropriate bus or day care van.
